## TEXAS

Texas broiler operators placed 3.56 million chicks during the week, up 6 percent from a year ago but down 21 percent from last week. Placements dropped 14 percent from the first of the month.

The weekly hatch totaled 4.17 million chicks, 82 percent of the eggs set during the week of October 5. The hatch was 4 percent above last year but 18 percent below the previous week.

Producers set 5.83 million eggs, an increase of 8 percent from a year earlier. The set was up 2 percent from last week.

Texas producers shipped 583,000 broiler chicks to Alabama and Arkansas, while no inshipments were received.

## NINETEEN STATES

In the nineteen leading broiler producing states, weekly placements totaled 84.24 million chicks, up 4 percent from last year and 1 percent from the previous week.

The weekly set increased 6 percent from last year to 102.61 million eggs. The set was up 7 percent from a week ago.
