Weekly broiler placements totaled 3.64 million chicks, an increase of 25 percent from last year and 2 percent from the previous week. Placements were down 12 percent from a month ago.

Texas producers hatched 4.29 million chicks, 81 percent of the eggs set during the week of October 12. The hatch was up 25 percent from a year earlier and 2 percent from last week.

Producers set 6.48 million eggs, 5 percent above a year ago. The set was up 11 percent from the previous week.

Texas producers shipped 643,000 broiler chicks to Alabama and Arkansas, while no inshipments were received.

In the nineteen leading broiler producing states, weekly placements totaled 82.02 million chicks, up 4 percent from last year but down 3 percent from the previous week.

The weekly egg set increased 7 percent from last year to 112.07 million eggs. The set was 9 percent above a week ago.
