- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 31.021(c), Education Code, as amended by
- 7 Chapters 581 (S.B. 810) and 705 (H.B. 3526), Acts of the 85th
- 8 Legislature, Regular Session, 2017, is reenacted and amended to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 (c) Money in the state instructional materials and
- 11 technology fund shall be used to:
- 12 (1) fund the instructional materials and technology
- 13 allotment, as provided by Section 31.0211;
- 14 (2) purchase special instructional materials for the
- 15 education of blind and visually impaired students in public
- 16 schools;
- 17 (3) pay the expenses associated with the instructional
- 18 materials adoption and review process under this chapter;
- 19 (4) pay the expenses associated with the purchase or
- 20 licensing of open education resource instructional material;
- 21 (5) pay the expenses associated with the purchase of
- 22 instructional material, including [intrastate] freight and
- 23 shipping and the insurance expenses associated with [intrastate]
- 24 freight and shipping;

- 1 (6) fund the technology lending grant program
- 2 established under Section 32.301;
- 3 (7) provide funding to the Texas School for the Blind
- 4 and Visually Impaired, the Texas School for the Deaf, and the Texas
- 5 Juvenile Justice Department; and
- 6 (8) pay the expenses associated with the instructional
- 7 materials web portal developed under Section 31.081.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 31.0211(c), Education Code, is amended
- 9 to read as follows:
- 10 (c) Subject to Subsection (d), funds allotted under this
- 11 section may be used to:
- 12 (1) purchase:
- 13 (A) materials on the list adopted by the
- 14 commissioner, as provided by Section 31.0231;
- 15 (B) instructional materials, regardless of
- 16 whether the instructional materials are on the list adopted under
- 17 Section 31.024;
- 18 (C) consumable instructional materials,
- 19 including workbooks;
- 20 (D) instructional materials for use in bilingual
- 21 education classes, as provided by Section 31.029;
- (E) instructional materials for use in college
- 23 preparatory courses under Section 28.014, as provided by Section
- 24 31.031;
- 25 (F) supplemental instructional materials, as
- 26 provided by Section 31.035;
- (G) state-developed open education resource

- 1 instructional materials, as provided by Subchapter B-1;
- 2 (H) instructional materials and technological
- 3 equipment under any continuing contracts of the district in effect
- 4 on September 1, 2011; [and]
- 5 (I) technological equipment necessary to support
- 6 the use of materials included on the list adopted by the
- 7 commissioner under Section 31.0231 or any instructional materials
- 8 purchased with an allotment under this section; and
- 9 (J) inventory software or systems for storing,
- 10 managing, and accessing instructional materials and analyzing the
- 11 usage and effectiveness of the instructional materials; and
- 12 (2) pay:
- 13 (A) for training educational personnel directly
- 14 involved in student learning in the appropriate use of
- 15 instructional materials and for providing for access to
- 16 technological equipment for instructional use; and
- 17 (B) the salary and other expenses of an employee
- 18 who provides technical support for the use of technological
- 19 equipment directly involved in student learning.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
