| 9  | accept for cremation unidentified human remains.                   |
| 10 | (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, a         |
| 11 | crematory establishment may accept for cremation unidentified      |
| 12 | human remains from a county on the order of:                       |
| 13 | (1) the county commissioners court; or                             |
| 14 | (2) a court located in the county.                                 |
| 15 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives        |
| 16 | a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  |
| 17 | provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this   |
| 18 | Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this |
| 19 | Act takes effect September 1, 2009.                                |
