8	only to a home-rule municipality that has a population of less than
9	10,000 and is located primarily in a county with a population of
10	more than 3.3 million.
11	(b) The municipality may annex the unincorporated area of an
12	airport owned by the municipality that is noncontiguous to the
13	boundaries of the municipality regardless of whether the airport is
14	located in the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction. The
15	annexation may include any unincorporated area located in the
16	proximity of the airport.
17	(c) The area described by Subsection (b) may be annexed
18	without the consent of the owners or residents of the area, but the
19	annexation may not occur unless each municipality in whose
20	extraterritorial jurisdiction the area may be located:
21	(1) consents to the annexation; and
22	(2) reduces its extraterritorial jurisdiction over
23	the area as provided by Section 42.023.
24	(d) If the area proposed for annexation is completely

- 1 surrounded by territory under the jurisdiction of another
- 2 municipality, regardless of whether that jurisdiction is
- 3 full-purpose, limited-purpose, or extraterritorial, that
- 4 municipality must find that the annexation is in the public
- 5 interest.
- 6 (e) Following annexation, territory annexed under this
- 7 <u>section is not required to be contiguous to the boundaries of the</u>
- 8 <u>annexing municipality.</u>
- 9 (f) The annexation of area under this section outside the
- 10 <u>extraterritorial jurisdiction of the annexing municipality does</u>
- 11 not expand the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the municipality.
- 12 (g) The municipality may annex the area if the area is
- 13 <u>narrower than the minimum width prescribed by Section 43.054.</u>
- 14 Section 43.055 does not apply to the annexation.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
