11 Civil Statutes) any real property owned by the state that the

12 legislature has authorized or the governor has approved for sale

under Subchapter E if the commissioner determines the sale is in the

14 best interest of the state.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

19 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
