- 6 Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the amount of a
- 8 full-time state employee's hazardous duty pay for a particular
- 9 month is [the lesser of:
- 10 [\(\frac{1}{1}\)] \$10 for each 12-month period of lifetime service
- 11 credit accrued by the employee[+ or
- $[\frac{(2)}{300}].$
- (d) For purposes of Subsections (a) (a) (a) and (b)(2),
- 14 the number of 12-month periods of lifetime service credit that the
- 15 employee has accrued must be determined as of the last day of the
- 16 preceding month.
- 17 SECTION 2. Subsection (c), Section 659.305, Government
- 18 Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
