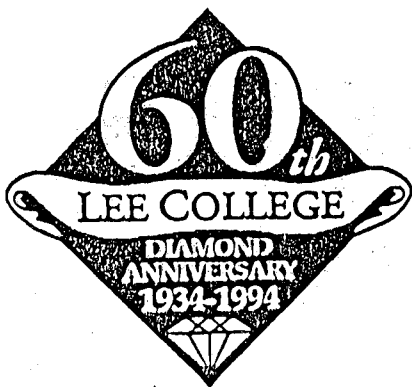
**There's Sunshine in a Smile**
