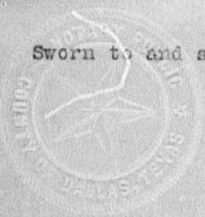

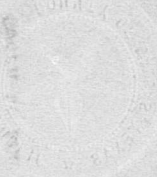

She would respectfully represent to the Court that in filing her former report, she, by an oversight, or a misapprehension of her duties, included the entire amount of the money received from the estate of J.H. Webb, deceased, when as a matter of fact, she should only have included the amount coming from said estate to her wards. The total amount of said estate was \$2184.92; of this amount, she was entitled to, individually, the sum of \$617.00; the estate was indebted to one D.T. Rainwater, by note, in the sum of \$265.00, which should have been deducted. These amounts were deducted, as shown by her inventory or report heretofore filed, but as a matter of fact these items should not have appeared in the report, nor should she have charged herself up with the entire amount of cash received from the estate.

With this explanation, she reports as follows:

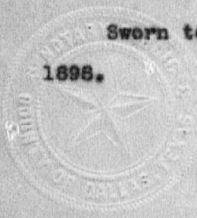
