personal property, of every sort whatsoever to be used by her during her life time or thereafter at her death, I direct that all the portions of my property held by her be divided equally between my three sons, Milton Josephine William Bennett

I appoint and constitute my wife Josephine Bennett executing of this my will without bond and direct that no further action be had by the probate court on my estate excepting the probating of this will and the filing of an inventory and appraisement of my property in said Court.
