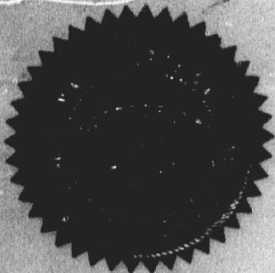

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, Carrie M. Harris, survivor of the Community of Thomas W. Harris, Deceased, and Carrie M. Harris, Administratrix of which estate is now pending in the County Court of Dallas County, Texas, as principal, and National Surety Co. of New York and _____ as sureties, are hereby well and truly bound unto H. F. LIVELY, County Judge of Dallas County, Texas, and his successors in office in the sum of TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED Dollars (\$2500.00) which we jointly and severally hereby promise to pay:

UPON CONDITION HOWEVER, that should I, the said Carrie M. Harris faithfully administer such estate, and pay over one-half the surplus thereof after the payment of the debts with which the whole of said property is properly chargeable, to such person or persons as shall be entitled to receive the same, then this bond shall be null and void, otherwise the same shall be and remain in full force and effect.

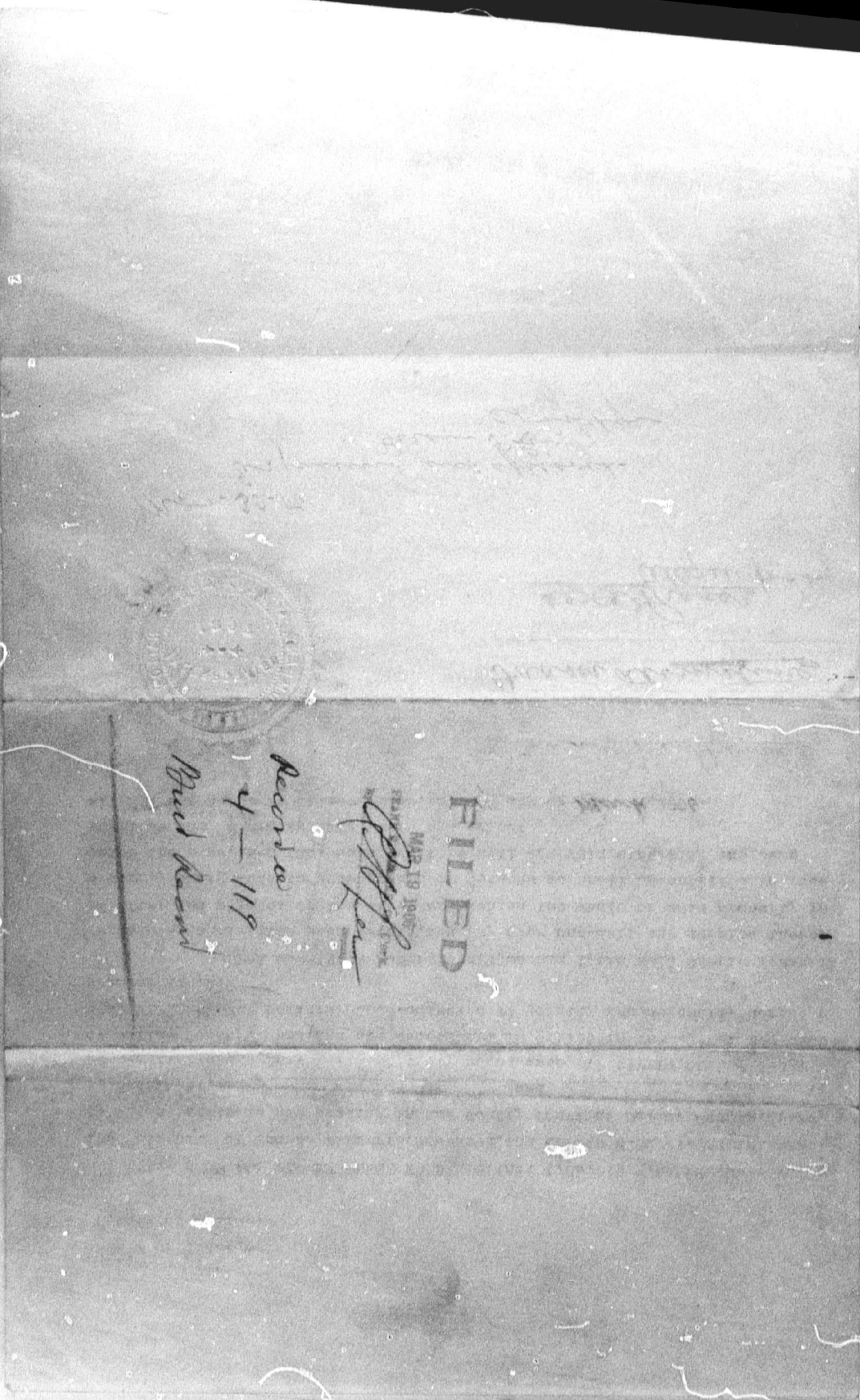
