County on 27th day of July 1867 to have
you removed from the Guardianship of
the person of Ann Thompson Girl of Color
Minor because the former Chief Justice
had no right or authority whatever
either in Law or Equity to grant you
said Guardianship

To all to whom these Presents may come--Greeting:

Know Ye, That John A. Thompson as principal, and Ed W. Hunt & John M. Law as sureties, are held and firmly bound unto the Chief Justice of the county of Dallas in the sum of Two Hundred and fifty Dollars, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made unto the said Chief Justice, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Signed with our hands, and sea'ed with our seals, the seals being scrolls, the 30th day of May A. D. 1866.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH That whereas the above bound John A. Thompson has been appointed Guardian of the Person of Sra. Thompson a colored Girl aged about nine years old Now, if the said John A. Thompson shall well and truly perform all the duties required of him under said appointment, then this obligation shall be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

County made an order appointing

without any notice thereof to your
petitioner or any one else, all
Contrary to Law and Equity,
because at the time said order
was made appointing said John
A. Thompson - Guardian of said
Aava Thompson, your petitioner
was then a Citizen of Tarrant County
and State of Texas and was the
mother and natural Guardian

thereof.

Your petitioner avers
that she is competent to support
and maintain said Awa Thompson
and that she is ready to verify
and having notified the said
John A. Thompson she prays a
hearing in this behalf.
