The State of Texas know all men by these presents
 County of Dallas that We George W Laws and
 principals and Jas P Thomas and W H Master
 as sureties, are held and firmly bound unto
 the County Judge of Dallas County Texas in
 the sum of one thousand dollars for the pay-
 ment of which well and truly to be made
 unto the said County Judge we bind ourselves
 our heirs, executors and Administrators jointly
 and severally, firmly by these presents, signed
 with our hands, and sealed with our seals,
 the seals being scrolls this 29th day of May
 A.D. 1867.

The condition of the above obligation is such
 that whereas the above bound Geo W Laws has
 been appointed Guardian of the Estate of
 Moses and Mary Bonner. Now if the said
 Geo W Laws shall well and truly perform
 all the duties required of him under said
 appointment, then this obligation shall be
 null and void, otherwise to remain in full
 force and effect.

To the Honorable J. Ellis Combes County Judge
of Dallas County Texas,
Your petitioner H. A. Laws who resides in the
County of Dallas and State of Texas, respect-
fully represents unto your Honor. - That here-
tofore, to-wit on the day of 18
E. O. Bonner, of the County of Dallas and State
of Texas, departed this life intestate leaving
several heirs at law to his estate; that two of
said heirs at law are minors, to-wit, Moses
Bonner, who is over the age of fourteen years,
and Mary Bonner, who is under said age of
fourteen years; that said Moses Bonner de-
sires that your petitioner be appointed guar-
dian of his said property coming to him
from said estate of E. O. Bonner, deceased; &
that your petitioner asks to be appointed guar-
dian of the said property of said minor
Mary Bonner, coming to her from the estate of
decedent.
