





On this the 6 day of March A. D. 1923 came on to be heard the application of the administrator herein, F. R. Bowles, filed on the 6th day of March A. Oliver, by deed dated 23rd Sept. 1903, as lots 18, 19 and 20 in block 9 of Webster and Woods North Park Addition to the city of Dallas, Texas, according to the map or plat thereof, recorded in Vol. 134 page 338 of the deed records of Dallas county Texas, and after the execution of the said deed by said F. R. Bowles, administrator of this estate, and the payment of all court costs due herein, there being no further necessity shown for administration, this estate be and the same is hereby closed and the said F. R. Bowles, be and he is hereby discharged as such administrator and his bondsmen released from further liability herein.
