Thence south-east parallel with McCoy Street and with O'Reilly's south-
west line 140 feet to corner. Thence south-west parallel with Ross
Avenue 83 1/2 feet to corner. Thence north-west parallel with McCoy
Street 140 feet to south-east line of Ross Avenue. Thence north-east
with south-east line of Ross Avenue 83 1/2 feet to the beginning; and
