To Hon. E. G. Bower, Judge of Dallas county, Texas.

Your petitioner, Mollie Campbell, respectfully shows that she is a resident of Dallas county, Texas <sup>and is 21 years of age.</sup> That her brother, Lucius <sup>M</sup> Campbell, died in said county, Dec. 22nd, 1898, and left surviving him a widow, Dora Campbell, and three children. Following are the names, ages and sex of said children, viz: Lucius R. Campbell, a boy aged eleven years the 22, Feb., 1892; Maud Campbell, a girl aged eight years the 4th of March, 1892; Ava Campbell, a girl aged six years the 5th of January, 1892. That the mother of said children, the said Dora Campbell died in said county about the 17th of April, 1890. Both of said decedents were residing in said Dallas county at the time of their decease. One of the said children, Ava, is now in Dallas county at the home of your petitioner. Lucius R. is temporarily in Navarro county, Texas, and the other, Maud Campbell, is in Tarrant county, Texas. Said decedents left no property either personal or real upon which to maintain and support said children. Said children have no uncle or aunt except your petitioner who is the nearest adult relative to them, that is now living. She has a home and some property with which she can maintain them comfortably and respectably and is desirous of doing so. wherefore petitioner prays that citation issue ~~to all~~ as the law requires, to all interested in the welfare of said minors, <sup>and</sup> answer this petition. That upon hearing hereof your petitioner be appointed guardian of the persons of said minors.
